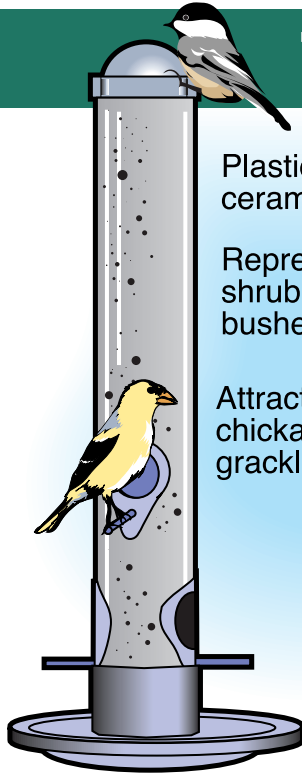


# CHOOSING THE RIGHT TYPE FEEDER

## Tube Feeder



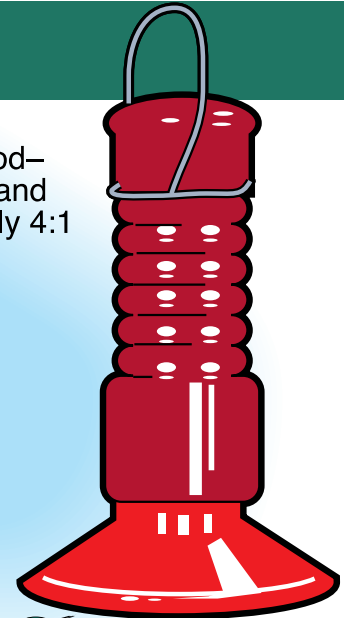
Plastic or ceramic.

Represents shrubs and bushes.

Attracts bluejays, cardinals, chickadees, titmice, grosbeaks, grackles, finches and others.

Preferred food— one of a kind seed— usually sunflower, peanut hearts, thistle or safflower.

## Nectar Feeder



Represents flowers.

Preferred food— white sugar and water. Usually 4:1 ratio.

Attracts hummingbirds and orioles.

## Platform Feeder or House/Box



Any flat surface or modified platform.

Represents the ground.

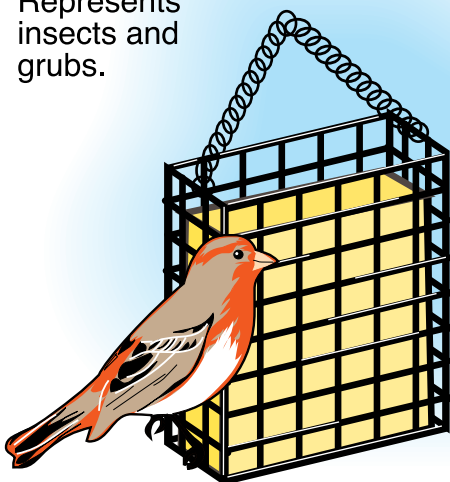
Preferred food— mixed seed. Similar to weed seeds found on the ground in an open area.

Attracts all seed eating birds and perching seed eaters.

## Suet Feeder

Coated wire or wire and wood.

Represents insects and grubs.

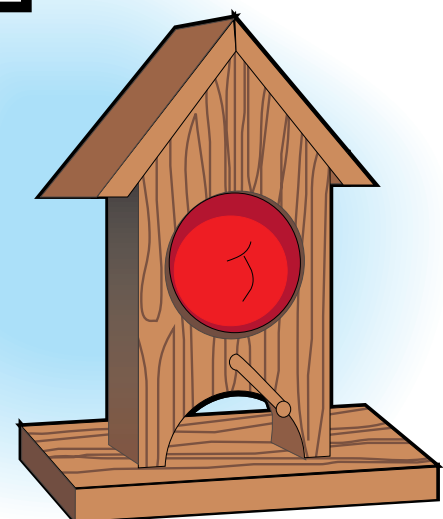


Preferred food— suet cakes.

Attracts woodpeckers, nuthatches, warblers, chickadees, titmice, thrasher, towhee, bluejay and others.

## Fruit Feeder

Upright or platform.



Represents berry bushes.

Preferred food— apples, oranges, currents, raisins and other fruits or nutmeats.

Attracts robins, bluejays, grosbeaks, orioles, bluebirds and others.
