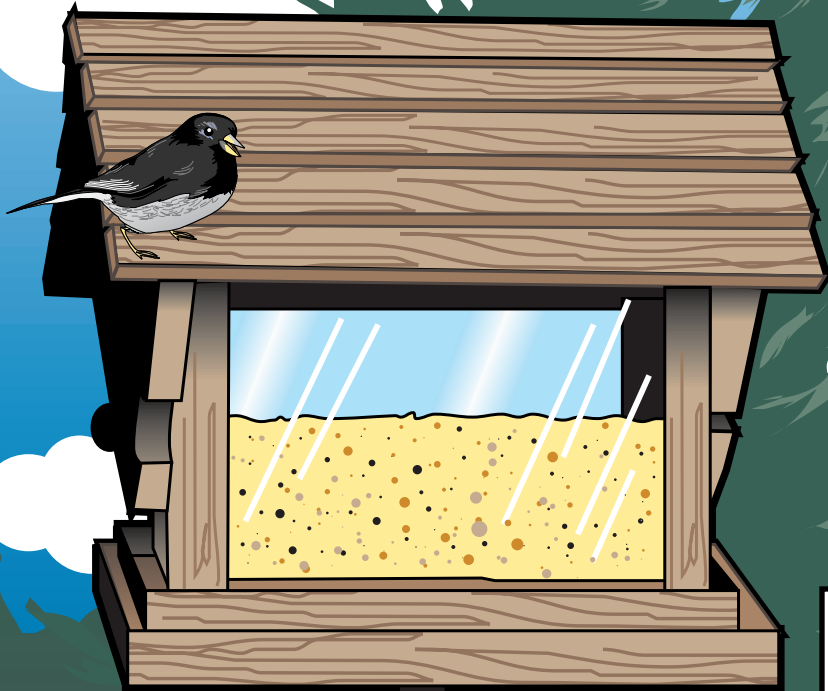


A Typical Backyard Feeding Station



Box or Tray Feeder

For ground feeding birds who like a variety of small mixed seeds.

Suet Feeder

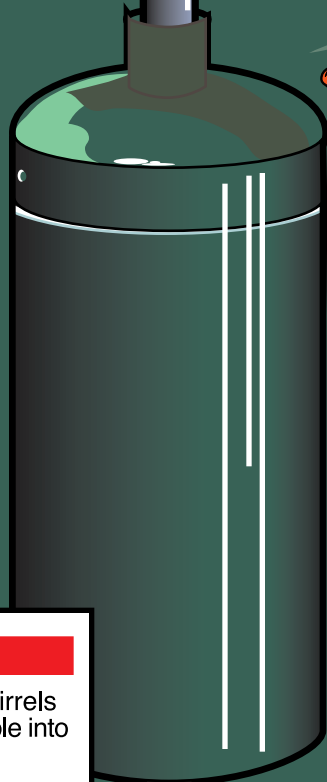
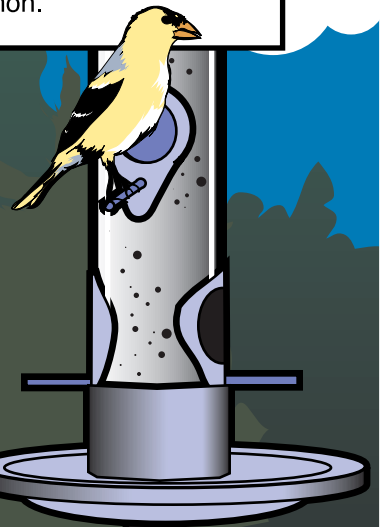
For the woodpeckers, wrens, chickadees, and nuthatches



Tube Feeder

For perching birds—especially those birds who like sunflower seeds.

Other specialty feeders may be used for providing birds with individual seeds. Thistle feeders are the most common.



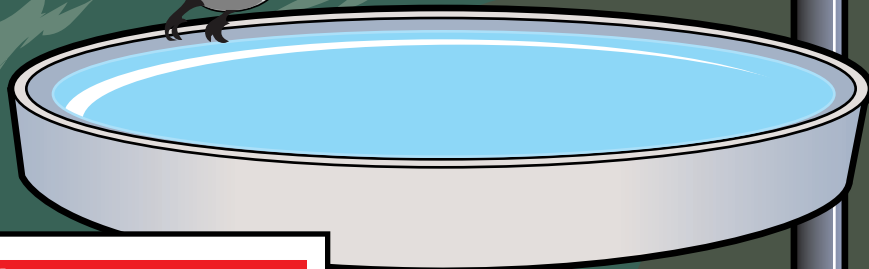
Pole Baffle

Designed to keep squirrels from climbing up the pole into the feeder.

Overhead Baffles may also be used to prevent climbing or jumping down from a tree or shrub onto the feeder.

Water

One of the most important extras that you can add and should supply.



Shelter

Be sure there is shelter nearby. It can be in the form of plants, shrubs, trees or brushpiles.
