



MOUNTING YOUR WINDOW BIRDFEEDER

To begin, window birdfeeders must be hung when the outside temperature is above freezing.

Prior to mounting your window birdfeeder, wash the window with Windex or similar product.

After the window dries, wipe off any residue with a clean paper towel.

Warm the suction cups of the feeder by rubbing them with your thumb and forefinger. (You can apply a *tiny* bit of oil to each cup if they are very stiff.)

Position the feeder where desired, and push on the back of the suction cups until you hear them 'burp'.

Do not push on the feeder itself, or you risk breaking the plastic.

If mounted properly, your feeder should not fall off your window unless it is disturbed by squirrels or other heavier animals.
